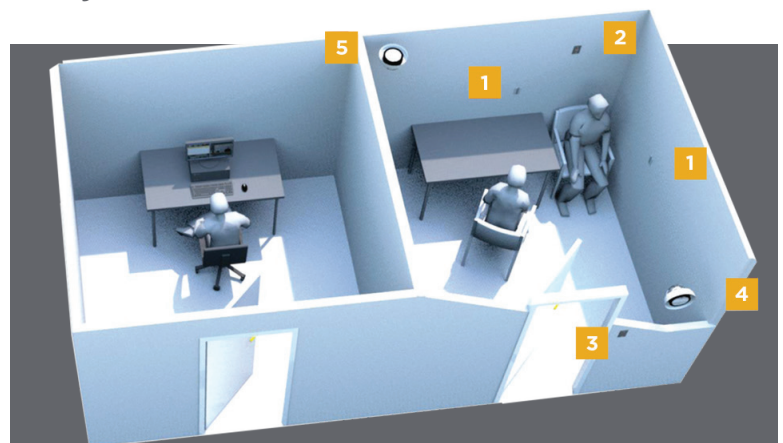

- 1 The microphones are close to the conversation, at head level for a seated adult on either side of the subject
- 2 The recording indicator light behind the subject, so the interviewer can see it at all times during the interview and know that the recorder is recording
- 3 The recording start button is just outside the door to the room
- 4 The close-up camera showing expressions and body language gives a clear view of subject’s face
- 5 The wide-angle camera on the ceiling shows all the activity in the room
